

### Jewish Democratic Council of America (JDCA) Grassroots Campus Fellowship (Paid)

#### **Description:**

*The Jewish Democratic Council of America (JDCA) is recruiting college students for a **paid** fellowship program for the Spring 2020 and Fall 2020 semesters. Fellows will work remotely on their respective campuses. We are accepting qualified applicants until Sunday February 2<sup>nd</sup> at midnight.*

- JDCA is the voice of Jewish Democrats representing a socially progressive, pro-Israel platform.
- JDCA played a critical role in the 2018 midterm elections by endorsing candidates, mobilizing the Jewish vote, and organizing volunteers.
- Our fellows will serve as JDCA's point people on the ground by mobilizing their peers, supporting JDCA's advocacy agenda and endorsed candidates, and by hosting events on campus and in the local community. Through this program, JDCA will encourage Jewish students to engage in the electoral process and ensure their voices are represented in local Democratic circles.

#### **Objectives:**

- **Organizing:** Fellows will recruit students on their campuses to participate in phonebanks, canvassing opportunities, and volunteer for local JDCA-endorsed candidates. Fellows should create or join larger coalitions supporting Democrats.
- **Events:** Hosting events on campus is a key tool for reaching the larger campus community. Fellows will be required to host, at minimum, one event per semester.

#### **Requirements:**

- Join a monthly training call with JDCA fellows from across the country, featuring exclusive speakers.
- Participate in a bi-weekly check-in with JDCA staff to discuss your work on campus.

#### **Compensation:**

- Fellows will receive a \$1,000 stipend which will be paid in two installments, the first at the end of the Spring semester and the second after Election Day in 2020.
