

Jewish Democratic Council of America Summer Organizing Fellowship (Paid)

Description:

The Jewish Democratic Council of America (JDCA) is recruiting incoming, current, and recently graduated college students for a **paid** fellowship program for the Summer of 2020. Fellows will work remotely in their respective communities. We are accepting applications on a rolling basis.

- JDCA is the voice of Jewish Democrats representing a socially progressive, pro-Israel platform.
- JDCA played a critical role in the 2018 midterm elections by endorsing candidates, mobilizing the Jewish vote, and organizing volunteers.
- Our fellows will serve as JDCA's point people on the ground by mobilizing their communities, supporting
 JDCA's advocacy agenda and endorsed candidates, and building a grassroots base by providing
 additional organizing capacity in JDCA's key states. Through this program, JDCA will encourage students
 and young voters to engage in the electoral process and ensure their voices are represented in local
 Democratic circles.

Objectives:

- Each fellow will each recruit at least 10 new activists to volunteer leading up to GOTV in the Fall.
- Each Fellow will host 3 volunteer engagement events, virtual phone or text banks with at least 10 participants.
- Each fellow will generate between 500 1,000 calls into target states. Through volunteer recruitment, each fellow will subsequently generate an additional 200-300 phone calls.

Requirements:

- Join a bi-monthly training call with JDCA fellows from across the country.
- Participate in a weekly check-in with JDCA staff.

Compensation:

- Fellows will receive a \$500 monthly stipend upon completion of objectives.
- Returning college students will also be eligible to participate in our Fall Campus Fellowship.
