Jewish Dems are organizing Jewish voters across California to defeat the recall of Democratic Governor Gavin Newsom.

WHO IS BEHIND THE RECALL?

The recall campaign against Governor Newsom has been organized by right-wing extremists, including anti-vaxxers and QAnon conspiracy theorists.

COULD THE GOP REALLY RECALL NEWSOM?

YES.

The GOP's campaign of misinformation poses a serious threat to Governor Newsom's future in office. They are depending on low voter turnout, and we know the California GOP is willing to use questionable tactics to win - in 2020, they admitted to placing over 50 fake drop boxes in California for mail-in ballots.

WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF REPUBLICANS SUCCEED?

The Republicans running reject Roe v. Wade; they have denied climate science; and they would have the power to make important political appointments in California.



If one of the Republican candidates challenging Governor Newsom had the opportunity to appoint a Senator, they would pick a Trump-loving Republican, and Democrats would lose the Senate majority.

WHEN IS THE RECALL ELECTION?



Early voting has already started in California, and election day is September 14.

The registration deadline (August 30) has now passed. Mail-in ballots must be postmarked by or dropped off by 8:00 p.m. PT on September 14.
