Over 300 Rabbis and Cantors Launch Jewish Spiritual Leaders Network in Support of Harris-Walz

On Friday, September 9, over 300 rabbis, cantors, and other Jewish faith and spiritual leaders announced the creation of a Spiritual Leaders Network in support of the Harris-Walz Campaign. The 300+ spiritual leaders are organizing to share Harris's record on Jewish issues, support the campaign, and assist in Jewish voter mobilization efforts. They are endorsing Harris-Walz because their values align with our values, which is why Jewish voters overwhelmingly support Harris-Walz.

The launch was accompanied by a letter of support citing the Vice President's long record as a partner to the Jewish community, supporter of Israel, and defender of our values, including defending democracy, pursuing justice, safeguarding civil rights, supporting Israel, and combating antisemitism. As the letter says, **“We know that Vice President Harris stands with Jewish Americans. We are proud to stand with her.”**
